Submission Instructions

Submission of proposals on sexuality and sex education

1. Oral communications (from research papers or practice reports) and posters will be accepted.
2. All abstracts should be directly related to the topics of the Conference and be written in Portuguese, Spanish or English.
3. All abstracts will be subject to a "blind review" so they must not contain any data that can identify authors and institutions.
4. Authors may submit at most two abstracts and / or a practice report.
5. In order for the accepted work to be included in the V CISES programme, at least one of the authors must register in the Conference.
6. Submission must be done exclusively by Easy Chair Platform. In no circumstances submissions will be admitted if not by Easy Chair platform.

Submission of research papers

Proposals must be submitted by an abstract of up to 1600 characters including spaces, excluding the title.

1. This abstract should contain the following:
 - Contextualization of the problem
 - Theoretical framework and objectives
 - Methodology
 - Main Results
 - Conclusions
 - Implications (for future investigations, policies and / or practices)
2. The following extension and structure guidelines should be respect:
 - Centred title.
 - Times New Roman font, size 11, single spacing.

Submission of practice reports

Proposals must be submitted with an abstract of up to 6000 characters including spaces, excluding the title.

1. The practice report may describe and reflect on the following:

- What was done?
- Why did you decide to do it?
- What happened?
- Which aspects went particularly well?
- What barriers/ difficulties were encountered and how were they overcome?
- How it has been assessed, and to what extent these practices have been successful?
- What can be learned from the practices carried out?

2. The reporting of practices should respect the following guidelines:

- Centred title.
- Times New Roman font, size 11, single spacing.

Submission of poster communications

1. Proposals must be submitted by an abstract of up to 1000 characters including spaces, excluding the title.

2. These proposals should present work experiences and ongoing research projects.

3. A prize will be awarded to the best poster. This award consists of a certificate of recognition of scientific merit and a symbolic book.

Full text to be published in the eBook of minutes

1. The full text is due September 20th.

2. Papers for publication will be submitted to a referee who will recommend those that should be included in the eBook of Minutes or in the eBook with the best papers.

3. The first author of each submission will receive the notification of acceptance for publication or rejection.

4. The full text should follow the topics of the abstract and not exceed 9000 words in length. This includes all text including references and appendices.

5. The text should be processed on a computer in Microsoft Word, with Times New Roman font size 12 and spacing between lines of 1.5.
6. Bibliographic references should be placed at the end of the work, following the APA style:
